Pennsylvania's bituminous coal industry: an industry review* t he bituminous coal field in pennsylvania covers most of western lpennsylvania, extending from the southwest corner northward almost to lake erie, eastward to the allegheny front, and northeast-ward through the north-central counties of the state to the southern boundary of new york.Pennsylvania's bituminous coal fields lie at the northern end of the appalachian coal fields, which extend from the commonwealth to alabama. bituminous coal underlies more than 14,000 square miles and parts of thirty-three counties in western pennsylvania.The northern field is located predominantly in the luzerne, lackawanna, susquehanna and wayne counties; the western middle field in northumberland, columbia, and schuylkill counties; eastern middle field mainly in luzerne county but extending into schuylkill, carbon, and columbia counties; the southern field in carbon, schuylkill, lebanon, and dauphin counties (latzko, 8).
