The admiralty type leader, sometimes known as the scott class, were a class of eight destroyer leaders designed and built for the royal navy towards the end of world war iey were named after scottish historical leaders. the function of a leader was to carry the flag staff of a destroyer flotilla, therefore they were enlarged to carry additional crew, offices and signalling equipment The v and w class were the ultimate evolution of british destroyer design in the first world war, embodying the improvements of their predecessors as well as new technological advances.
