Bernard Lightman is professor of humanities at York University, Toronto, Canada. He is a fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, former editor of the journal *Isis*, and vice-president and president elect of the History of Science Society. Professor Lightman has published over 50 articles and is the author of *Origins of Agnosticism* (1987) and *Victorian Popularizers of Science* (2007). Bernard Lightman, Ph.D. (1979), Brandeis University, is professor of humanities at York University, current editor of *Isis*. His major publications include *Origins of Agnosticism* (Johns Hopkins, 1987), *Victorian Science in Context* (Chicago, 1997), and *Victorian Popularizers of Science* (Chicago, 2007). Gordon McQuat, Ph.D. 1996, University of Toronto, is professor of history of science.
