The royal photographic society is a charity which exists to educate members of the public by increasing their knowledge and understanding of photography and in doing so to promote the highest standards of achievement in photography in order to encourage public appreciation of photography. In 1874 it was renamed the photographic society of great britain, and from 1894 it became known as the royal photographic society of great britain. a registered charity since 1962, [2] in july 2004, the royal photographic society of great britain was granted a royal charter recognising its eminence in the field of photography as a learned society .The royal photographic society of great britain, commonly known as the royal photographic society (rps), is one of the world's oldest photographic societies was founded in london, england in 1853 as the photographic society of london with the objective of promoting the art and science of photography, and in 1854 received royal patronage from queen victoria and prince albert. John cimon warburg (1867-1931) british photographer. he took up photography in the late 1880s, becoming a member of the royal photographic society in 1897. warburg experienced a wide range of photographic processes, but excelled at autochromes. he is best known for his atmospheric landscapes and charming studies of his children. In the early 1890's, the idea behind the formation of the photographic salon in england was a simple one: difference of opinion. organized by the linked ring brotherhood, a group of like-minded photographers with an international roster, the salon's aims were in advancing and promoting artistic photography. Travel photography – anything that records an impression of a time and place. environmental portraits, architecture, landscape, street life and still life. if it identifies a location, event or show, it qualifies as photographic travel. The royal photographic society is an educational charity founded in 1853 ‘to promote the art and science of photography’. with a membership open to everyone the society is the uk's largest organisation representing photographers with over 11,000 members in the uk and abroad. In 1911 one critic, charles e. dawson, wrote in the penrose pictorial annual and ranked her work alongside "the best works of kasbier, duhroop, baron de mayer, steichen, demachy, puyo, and the other photographic giants" peter james of the birmingham central library put on one exhibition featuring emma barton's work.
