Archaic greece was the period in greek history lasting from the eighth century bc to the second persian invasion of greece in 480 bc, following the greek dark ages and succeeded by the classical periode period began with a massive increase in the greek population and a series of significant changes which rendered the greek world at the end of the eighth century entirely unrecognisable Ancient greek civilization - classical greek civilization: between 500 and 386 bc persia was for the policy-making classes in the largest greek states a constant preoccupation. The achaemenid empire (c. 550-330 bce), sometimes known as first persian empire, was an empire in southwest asia, founded in the 6th century bce by cyrus the great who overthrew the median confederation.Successors of rome: francia, 447-present. kings and emperors of the franks, france, burgundy, italy, and germany. introduction. after the collapse of the western roman empire, and the occupation of much of gaul by the franks, roman power never returned far enough to come into conflict with the frankish kingdom (except, to an extent, in the south of italy).
