The spanish empire (spanish: imperio español; latin: imperium hispanicum), historically known as the hispanic monarchy (spanish: monarquía hispánica) and as the catholic monarchy (spanish: monarquía católica) was one of the largest empires in history. from the late 15th century to the early 19th, spain controlled a huge overseas territory in the new world and the asian archipelago of the Upper louisiana, also known as the illinois country, was the french territory in the upper mississippi river valley, including settlements and fortifications in what are now the states of missouri, illinois, and indiana. french exploration of the area began with the 1673 expedition of louis joliet and jacques marquette, which charted the upper mississippi.
