Sir Walter Scott, 1st Baronet Frise (15 August 1771 – 21 September 1832) was a Scottish historical novelist, poet, playwright and historian. Many of his works remain classics of both English-language literature and of Scottish literature. Famous titles include *Ivanhoe*, *Rob Roy*, *Old Mortality*, *The Lady of the Lake*, *Waverley*, *The Heart of Midlothian* and *The Bride of Lammermoor*. What is now Middlesex University was originally a vision for a people's university: a polytechnic that would unite science, society and creativity, theory and practice, gas engineers and sociologists. The dynamic centre for this vision was Enfield College of Technology, a cluster of utilitarian buildings hidden behind houses, factories, shops and public houses on Hertford Road at Ponders End.
